Ranger Woody Writes are a series of quick, fun activities designed to get students generating writing ideas. Each activity can be done orally or it can be a writing or drawing activity for students to do alone or with a friend. Do you only have five minutes? Read aloud the card and answer aloud. Do you have half an hour? Then read aloud a card, discuss it and write the answer all together or allow students to individually write or illustrate their ideas. For younger students, it helps to discuss and ask the students for ideas. List their ideas on the board to help them with spelling and to keep their ideas flowing quickly.

There are 18 activity cards. Use the cards many times so that students get more comfortable with the activities and encourage more and more detail each time an activity is repeated.
